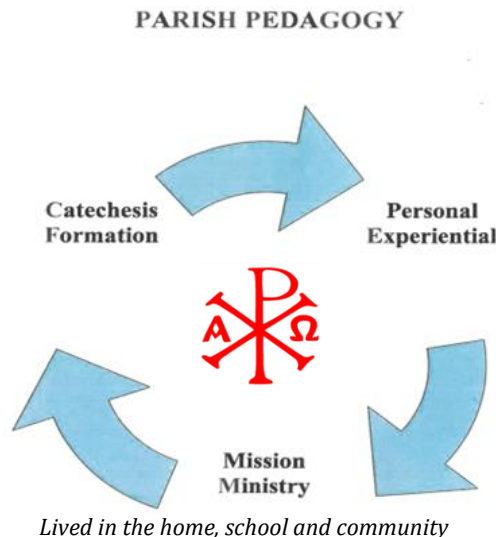

COVID-19 Ministry Event Programming

At-Home COVID-19 Health Screening Guide

To facilitate best practices and otherwise respect others also intending to participate in Ministry Events, individuals seeking to participate in a Ministry Event are to perform a pre-event self-health screening.

- **Recent close contact with a person with COVID-19.** Within 14 days of the Ministry Event, if you have had close contact with a person with COVID-19, please do not attend the Ministry Event; stay home and take care of yourself. We welcome your attendance at a subsequent event after the prescribed period of quarantine is over and you are clear!
- **Individual Body Temperature Check.** If an individual has a fever of 100.4 or above before he or she intends to leave to attend a Ministry Event, that person should remain at home. We look forward to seeing you at a later date when you are in good health!
- **Check for additional COVID-19 Symptoms.** If the individual seeking to participate is experiencing any of the symptoms below, please have the individual stay home and contact their medical care provider.
 - **Fever or chills**
 - **Cough**
 - **Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing**
 - **Fatigue**
 - **Muscle or body aches**
 - **Headache**
 - **New loss of taste or smell**
 - **Sore throat**
 - **Congestion or runny nose**
 - **Nausea or vomiting**
 - **Diarrhea**

BACKGROUND

COVID-19, a new type of coronavirus, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. Though the science behind COVID-19 continues to evolve, it is reported to be contagious, and is currently thought to spread predominantly from person-to-person contact. Further, it appears an individual may be infected, show no symptoms, but nonetheless be capable of spreading the virus. At present, the exact methods of virus spread and contraction are not fully understood. Additionally, there is no known treatment, cure, or vaccine. Evidence has shown that in some individuals, COVID-19 can cause serious/potentially life-threatening illness, and even death. As Colorado emerged from 2020's stay-at-home/safer at home phases, prevention methods have nonetheless been identified and can be taken. The Archdiocese, its ministries, and its parishes, have therefore adopted and follow applicable mandates, protocols and guidelines issued by federal, state and local jurisdictions that are guiding in-person activities locally and nationally. Successful in-person interaction nonetheless requires disciplined cooperation by all; it is therefore incumbent upon Ministry Event Participants to follow the COVID-19 Ministry Event Protocols & Guidelines.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK

The Archdiocese, its ministries and its parishes cannot prevent Participants from becoming exposed to, contracting, or spreading COVID-19, or any other virus or disease, while attending a Ministry Event. **It is simply not possible to prevent against the presence of the virus.** If an individual chooses to participate in a Ministry Event, the Participant/Participant's family members may be exposed to and/or be at increased risk of contracting or spreading COVID-19, or any other virus or disease. **Participant, either individually or on behalf of Participant's minor child, as applicable (collectively Participant) therefore acknowledges that Participant's attendance at the Ministry Event is of such value to the Participant that Participant is voluntarily choosing to participate in the Ministry Event at Participant's own risk.** The Archdiocese of Denver and/or hosting Parish, as applicable, is not responsible if a Participant/Participant's family contracts COVID-19 whether during or around the period of Participant's attendance at the Ministry Event.

COMMITMENT TO FOLLOW MINISTRY EVENT PROTOCOLS AND GUIDELINES.

Before and during a Ministry Event, **Participant commits to abide by** the COVID-19 Ministry Event Protocols & Guidelines, including the At-Home COVID-19 Health Screening Guide.
